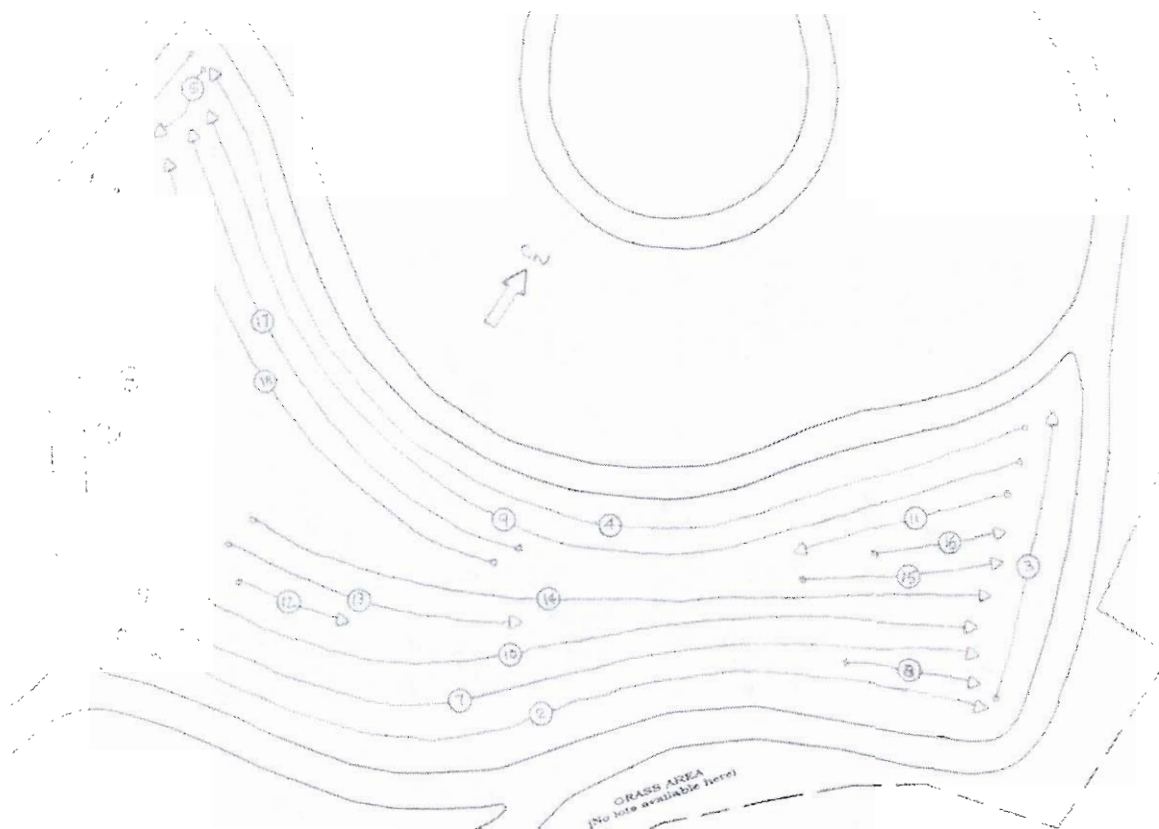

# MOUNT HERMON CEMETERY TOMBSTONE INSCRIPTIONS

The rows in this section start at the north-west corner then run in a counterclockwise direction beginning with the monuments on the perimeter. Subsequent rows work inward following the general counterclockwise pattern. Rows in the southern half of the section run in a general west-to-east direction while those in the northern half run in a general east-to-west direction. Most of the monuments face outwards towards the surrounding cemetery access road.

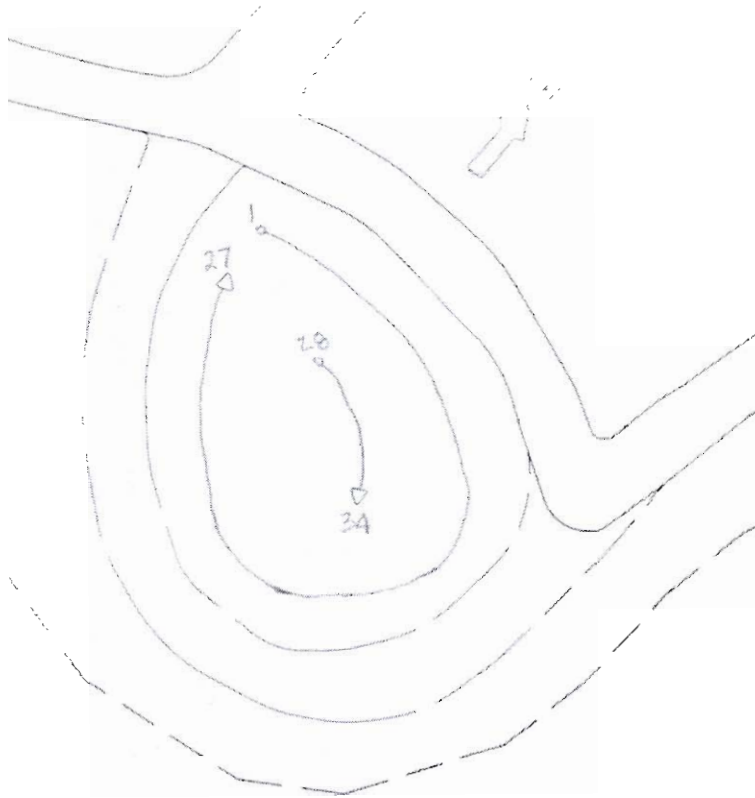

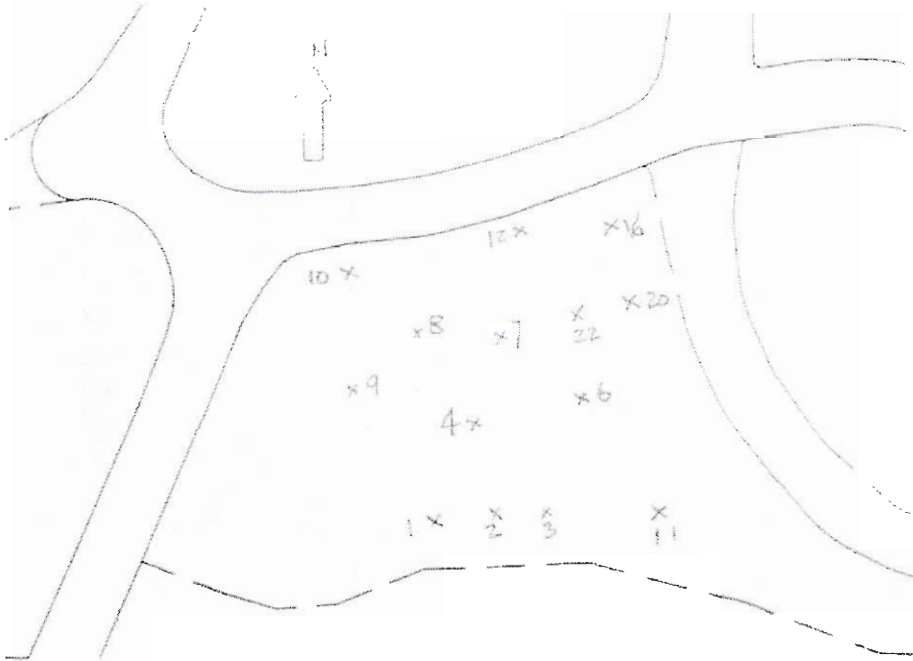

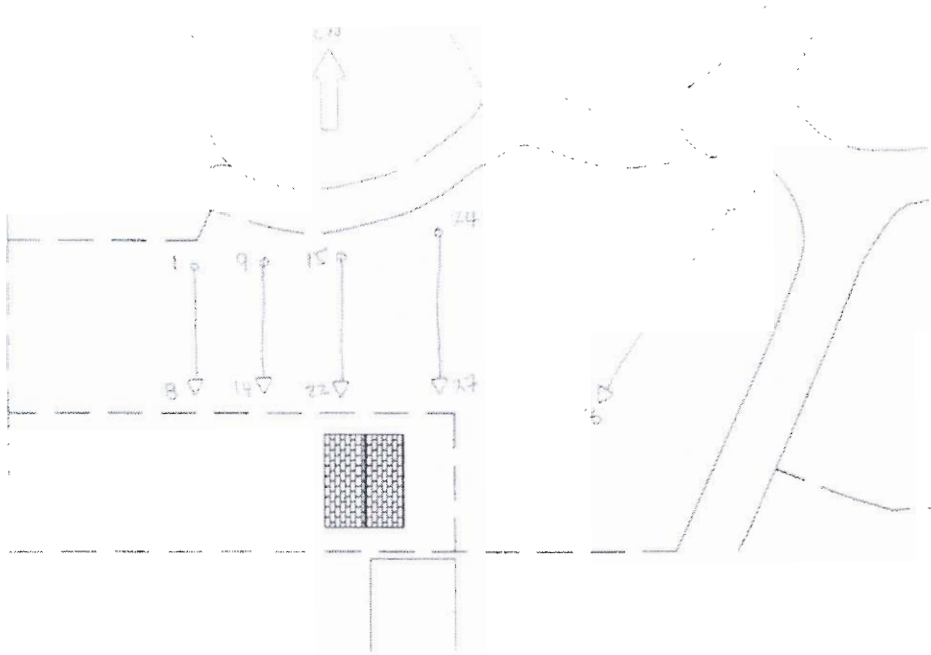
