[**Editor's Note:** Ft. St. Frederic was built by the French in 1731, just north of the present bridge that crosses Lake Champlain at Crown Point, New York. The French had made inroads in the territory since 1723 when they built a stockade on this site.

Boundary lines were rather vague between the French of Canada and the English of the Colonies. It can be assumed that the French knew they were in English territory, although the French claimed the land as theirs because of Samuel de Champlain's discoveries in 1609. The English claimed the territory because of their alliance with the Indians of the area. The French wished to prevent the English and Dutch from trading with the Indians. The Crown Point site was a gathering place for trade. It was also an ideal military site, as it controlled the north-south water-way of Lake Champlain. The English felt the French were a threat to New York and Massachusetts.

The French encouraged settlement of the area, and some settlers had settled the around the three small forts that were eventually built there.

When the French and Indian Wars broke out the French were understaffed, and were, also, hampered by outdated weaponry (cannon excavated from the site were 1500 century relics). In 1759 when the British General Jeffery Amhurst captured Ft Carillon (Ft Ticonderoga), fifteen miles to the south, the French blew up Ft St Frederic and retreated north.

The abrupt retreat of the French has afforded present day archaeologist and historians a wealth of material in revealing how the eighteenth century French lived. General Amhurst was delighted with the acquisition of this strategic piece of real estate, and promptly put all available help to work to build Ft Crown Point, a fort and area much larger than Ft. Ticonderoga. They used the destroyed French forts for redoubts near the main fort.

Because of a fire to the main fort and the lax upkeep of the fort when the American Revolution broke out Fort Crown Point was not useful for military protection of the area. The Americans deemed it useless when they captured it in 1775.

The NYS Conservation Dept. acquired 360 acres in the areas of these ruined forts. Some restorations have been Done, and the area is used for recreation with camp sites and picnic areas installed. I am not sure of the extent of the restorations, but I believe some of the fort area has been repaired and a museum is also at the site.]

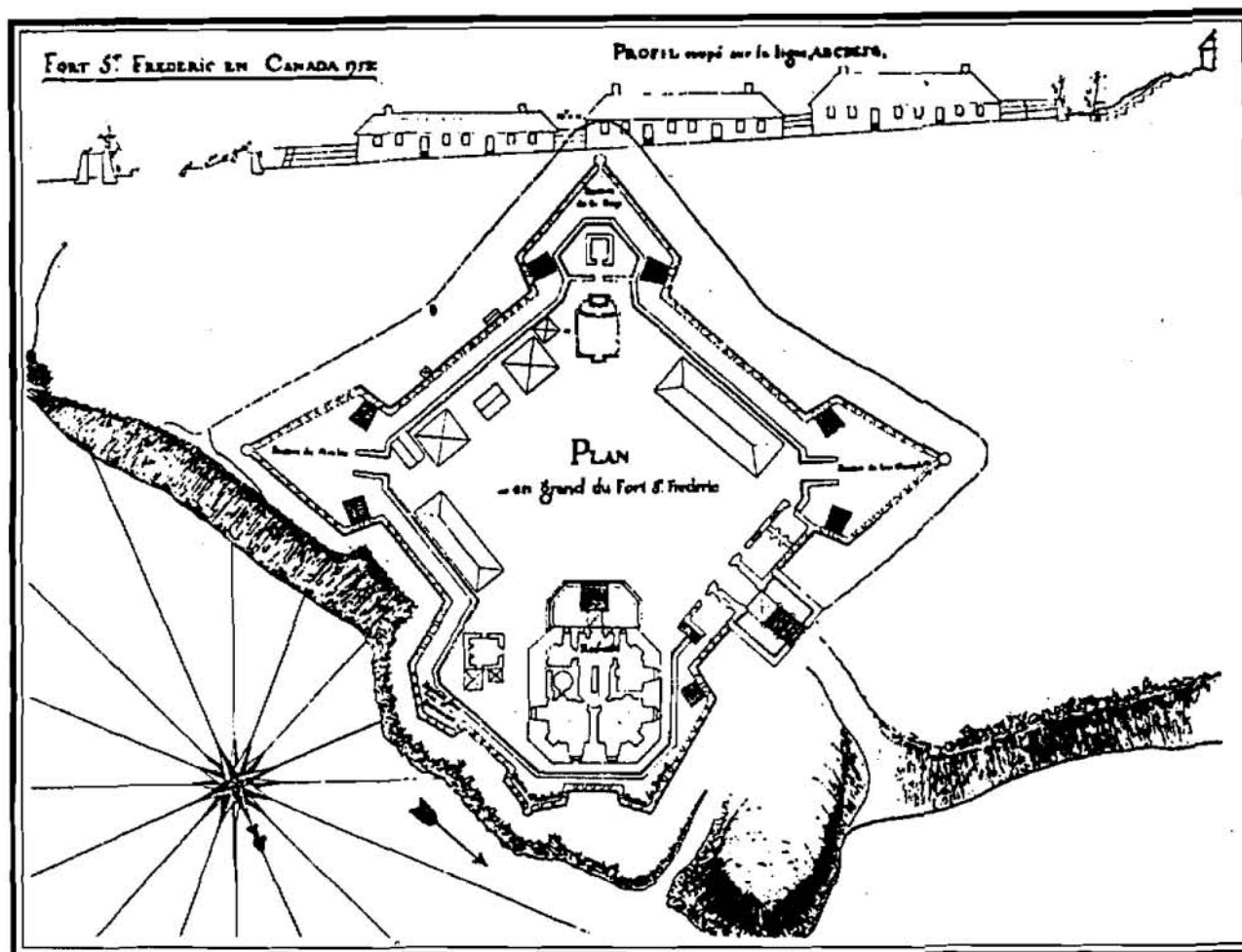

in the new French colony, priests acted in that

It is important to note that the same name may
be spelled in several different ways. Family rela-
tionships may readily be envisioned by a careful
study of these records.

Quite often a child was named for its sponsor.
All French infants were named for saints. Most
girls names were preceded by the name "Marie." It
is common to find a boy named Louis-Marie or a
girl named Marie-Joseph.

The matter of the extra name, such as Francois
Varlet called Lavertu or Joseph Lafoy called Pret-
a-boire (Ready-to-Drink) is very intriguing. These
extra names were legal.

Tragic times are reflected by the death records
in such years as 1747 and 1756. The records come
to an abrupt halt on July 31, 1759 when Ft St
Frederic was blown up and the garrison retreated
to Ile-aux-Noix. □
